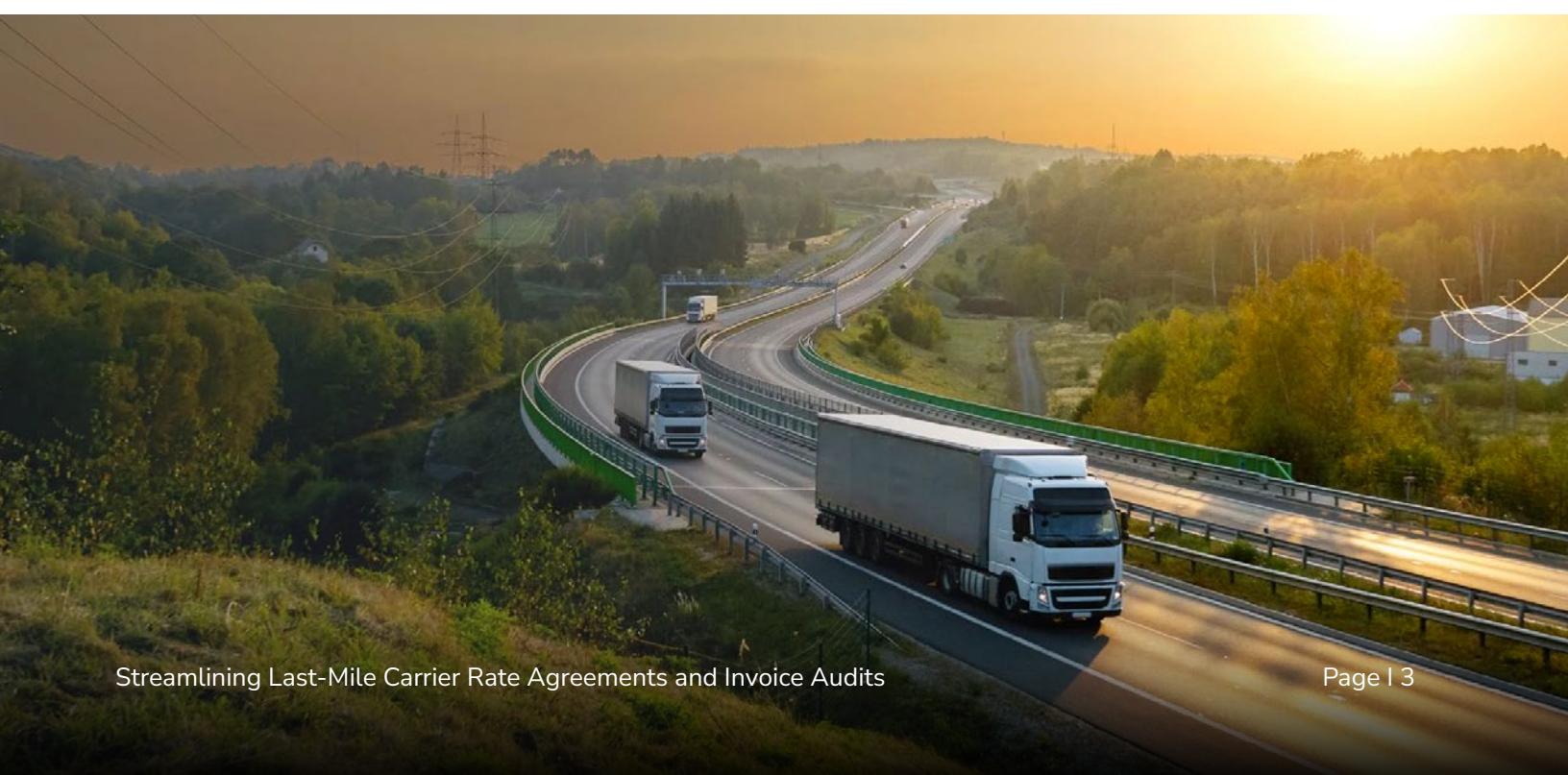

Eliminating Duplicate Bills

Duplicate invoices, whether repeated accessorial charges, altered invoice numbers, or separate billing for the same shipment, present significant challenges in terms of process and cost management. When one large retailer came to Cass for a solution, it knew it had a problem with duplicates and knew it wasn't catching many of them. In the retailer's first year and a half with Cass, we identified and prevented \$63 million in duplicate costs.

Improving ERP Shipment Status

Cass's validation capabilities enhance enterprise resource planning (ERP) shipment visibility. For example, although ERP systems often mark shipments as "delivered," real-world updates vary: "scheduled," "out for delivery," "delayed," or "cancelled."

Analyzing these variations reveals valuable insights. A spike in "cancelled" orders may signal scheduling issues, whereas frequent "delayed" updates could indicate carrier performance gaps. Detecting these patterns helps teams prioritize corrective actions and improve last-mile operations.

Enhancing Shipment Records

By unifying data from multiple sources, Cass links ERP shipment files with customer signatures, timestamps, and doorstep photos provided by their carriers. This creates a verifiable chain of evidence for each delivery, confirming what was delivered, when, and to whom. It strengthens accountability, reduces disputes, and simplifies audits.

Validating Accessorial

Accessorial charges, such as fuel surcharges, liftgate fees, and detention, are common. Cass matches ERP shipment files with carrier-submitted data. Discrepancies, like a liftgate fee on a shipment that didn't require it, are flagged immediately. Over time, teams can identify trends, differentiate unavoidable charges from errors, and refine operational standards.
